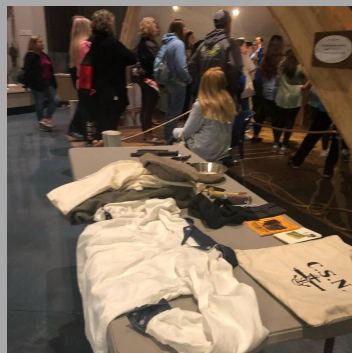

### PROGRAM OPTIONS

- 1) Soldier life- discuss the items a soldier would carry into battle and explore the differences in land and water battles.
- 2) Sailor life and rope making-learn about life on the CSS Neuse and how to make rope.
- 3) Navigation-learn how 19th Century sailors navigated waterways.
- 4) 19th Century toys, games, & amusements- students will discover the items families and sailors used to entertain themselves in the 19th century).
- 5) Shipbuilding- students will demonstrate their knowledge of buoyancy by creating their own boat. They will have the opportunity to see if their boat can hold cargo (a penny).
- 6) Food Preservation- learn how 19th Century soldiers would keep their rations fresh while on the march. Students will also learn about preserving food on the homefront (chemistry).
- 7) Textiles- discover how clothes were created and dyed during the 19th century and compare them to today's methods.
- 8) Blockade Running & the Economy- learn how blockade running impacted the Southern economy during the Civil War.
